## DESCRIPTION OF THE ADVERTISEMENT

The television advertisement depicts a motionless pose by two 'performance artists', subsequent shots showing it to be a presentation on stage before a bored audience. Captions read: 'Bored stiff with regular television? Then subscribe to the World Movies channel.' The advertisement ends with contact details on screen as a voiceover asks, 'Are you ready for World Movies?'

## THE COMPLAINT

Comments which the complainants made regarding this advertisement included the following:

'.... a woman depicting the Virgin Mary supporting the dead weight of the crucified Christ ..... Do you know what blasphemy you've allowed?'

'As a Christian I know I'm supposed to turn the other cheek, but I can't see a Taoist, Buddhist doing it, and certainly not a militant Moslem.'

## THE DETERMINATION

The Advertising Standards Board ('the Board') considered whether this advertisement breaches Section 2 of the Advertiser Code of Ethics ('the Code').

The Board determined that the material within the advertisement did not constitute discrimination or vilification; neither did it breach the Code on any other grounds. The Board, accordingly, dismissed the complaint.
